Rules of Entry

- The contest is open to students in K-12th grade.
- Pins must be primed with paint before they are designed.
- Create a bowling pin design using arts & crafts items, like paint, glitter, pens, marker, scraps of paper, etc.
- Here are a few ideas:
 - Cartoon character
 - School mascot
 - Modern art
 - Environmental design
 - Education theme

- Once your design is complete, write your name, age, phone number and school on the bottom of the pin, or attach an index card with these details.

- Winners will be notified by Oct. 24. Winners will be listed on the JA Facebook page and a press release about the winners will be sent to the winning students' local newspapers.
